Who could possibly be in such desperate need of psychological help? Try Chuck Schumer, Hakeem Jeffries, and virtually every other Democrat officeholder on Capitol Hill.

Recently, Jeffries, the House minority leader, recorded an embarrassing and delusional video in which he resembled a hostage being forced by his captors to read from a self-incriminating script. Staring straight ahead like the proverbial deer caught in the headlights, Jeffries made a series of outlandish claims that made viewers wonder if he was tripping out on Quaaludes.

"We have the Republicans on the run on three core issues", Jeffries began, perhaps forgetting that the GOP just won the White House, Senate, and House trifecta in November. Jeffries' second false narrative was that "We have them on the run in terms of health care - particularly as it relates to Medicaid. House Democrats stand on the side of Medicaid and the American people. Republicans are trying to enact the largest cut to Medicaid in American history, and we need to keep the pressure on them legislatively and in communities all across the country."

Sorry, Hakeem, but a recent Harvard CAPS / Harris poll showed that the American public supports President Trump, Elon Musk, D.O.G.E., and their cost-cutting measures by a whopping 76%-24% super majority. OUCH!

As for Jeffries' third point, it was about as desperate as a Hail Mary pass at the end of a football game that your team is losing by 30 points. "And we have them on the run with respect to the GOP tax scam," Jef-
