The Danger of **Playing Politics with Police Shootings**

Another day, another egregious and unwarranted police shooting of a black American... or at least that's what the liberal left and the mainstream media would have vou to believe.

The details are still coming out about the shooting of Sonya Massey, a 36-year-old mother of two who was killed in her own kitchen by Sheriff's Deputy Sean Grayson of Sangamon County, Illinois. Reportedly, Ms. Massey had called 911 to report a possible intruder in her Springfield home on July 6th. Thirty minutes later, she was dead.

A Tale of Two Countries

When Charles Dickens penned his classic historical novel A Tale of Two Cities, he sought to describe the differences between a calm and civilized London and the unrest and upheaval of Paris before and during the French Revolution. Sounds eerily familiar, doesn't it? Change a few historical and geographic references and the story could be an accurate description of the United States in the year 2024.

Never before in my lifetime have I

seen our country so polarized and almost equally divided. It is almost as if the ghosts of Abraham Lincoln and Jefferson Davis, Ulysses S. Grant and Robert E. Lee have risen from their graves to fight once again for the right to determine our nation's destiny. "Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand," Jesus said in Matthew 12:25. "A house divided against itself cannot stand," Lincoln echoed in one of his most famous speeches.

In Lincoln's case, he went on to say that "I believe this government cannot endure permanently half slave and half free. I do not expect the Union to be dissolved - I do not expect the house to fall - but I do expect it will cease to be divided. It will become all one thing or all the other."

Truer - and more prophetic - words have never been spoken in American history, because after four long years of war and the loss of more than 600,000 soldiers and countless civilians, it was no longer legal to buy, sell, or own another human being.

Fast forward to 2024, and we are once again a house divided. Don't believe me? Just look at a recent poll by Statista's Consumer Insights which shows that inflation is the #1 issue across all political spectrums. After that, however, it is an absolute free-for-all with liberals listing health/social security, climate change, and poverty as their next

nated after the event, but his union has filed a complaint, claiming he was fired "without just cause." Hopefully, the truth will come out and justice will be served. Either Deputy Grayson felt threatened and fired in self defense or he acted inappropriately and should be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

It will take time to determine the facts of the case, which is why politicians, pastors, and pundits should refrain from jumping to conclusions to advance their own agendas. "Sonya Massey deserved to be safe," Vice President Kamala Harris told reporters, adding that she and her husband, second gentleman Doug Emhoff, were "grieving her senseless death."

That's not very helpful nor is it very responsible, Ms. Harris, because we don't know all the details of the shooting. Certainly, as a former prosecutor, district attorney, and attorney general, you understand how dangerous it is for anyone - let alone the vice president of the United States and a candidate for the presidency - to rush to judgment in such a case. However, in this instance, there were political points to be made and so, Ms. Harris threw her law enforcement background out the window in favor of scoring a few headlines and swaying a few voters with her intentionally inflammatory comments.

The truth of the matter is that although the trend of fatal police shootings in the United States has

increased from 981 in 2017 to 1,163 in 2023, the majority of the victims were white. In 2024 to date, just 98 (21%) of the 469 civilians who have been shot by police were black.

With black Americans comprising roughly 12% of the general population, it is easy to claim that some of those shootings were racially motivated. However, it would also be intellectually dishonest to make that assertion because, according to the FBI and the Bureau of Justice Statistics, black Americans commit a disproportionate number of all violent crimes.

For instance, there were 461,540 violent crimes committed in 2020: 274,280 (59%) by white Americans and 167,030 (36%) by black Americans. That means that black Americans account for three times more violent crimes than their percentage of the general population.

Statistics don't lie, but politicians running for office often do and sadly, their lies continue to fan the flames of racial division that are tearing our country apart. It is far better to remain silent and reserve judgment until all the facts are known than to add fuel to the racial fires that are burning down our inner cities and our nation as a whole.

Meanwhile, law enforcement officers - the vast majority of whom are both competent and courageous - are being unfairly demonized by the media and the masses. It is no wonder why many jurisdictions are finding it difficult to recruit enough officers to fill their ranks... and that is what should trouble law-abiding Americans across every race and ethnicity.

I was a junior in high school when Saturday Night Live (originally called NBC's Saturday Night) first aired during the 1975-1976 TV season. It became an instant hit, especially with younger viewers who were anxious to stay up late on weekends and loved the irreverent humor.

Our parents had the Tonight Show with Johnny Carson, but we had the Not Ready for Prime Time Players.

The original cast consisted of (in alphabetical order): Dan Akroyd, John Belushi, Chevy Chase, George Coe (whom I only vaguely remember), Jane Curtain, Garrett Morris, Laraine Newman, Michael O'Donoghue (whom I don't recall at all), and Gilda Radnor. Who can forget "Weekend Update" hosted by "I'm Chevy Chase and you're not"... or Point/Counter-Point with Akroyd and Curtain imitating James Kilpatrick and Shana Alexander of "60 Minutes"? And then there was Radnor's portrayal of the hard-ofhearing Emily Litella and the brash Roseanne Roseannadanna. What a show!

When Chase left after SNL's inaugural season to pursue a movie ca-

reer, he was replaced by comic icon Bill Murray. Akroyd and Belushi left after Season 2 to launch their own movie careers and for all intents and purposes, SNL lost its momentum and much of its audience (including me).

Nowadays, when people refer to SNL it is usually with the tagline, "Remember when Saturday Night Live used to be funny?"
